The following summarizes the judging activities on each of the two days:

Preliminary Judging - Wednesday, March 10, 8:45 am to 2:00 pm

- View all of the projects in your assigned category
- Work jointly with other judges on your team
- Rank projects into 1st (highest), 2nd and 3rd honors
- Students are not present

Final Judging - Thursday, March 11, 8:30 am to 1:15 pm

- View the finalists' projects in your assigned category
- Work independently of the other judges to foster a one-on-one exchange with the student
- Projects are scored numerically; judging criteria will be provided
- Students are present to describe their work to the judges

On Wednesday and Thursday, a continental breakfast will be provided starting at 7:30 am and a judge's buffet lunch will also be provided. Refreshments will be available throughout the day.
